<u>Monday folders (Green)</u>: Papers, homework, and notes will be coming home in a green take home folder. Please be sure this folder is emptied and returned to school each and every Friday.

Homework: We will attempt to complete all assignments in class, so nightly homework should be limited. Students will however be responsible for the following:

- ★ At least 25 minutes of nightly reading. Books should be within their level. (Student should always know their current level) Reading logs to be signed by parent or guardian each night.
- ★ At least 10 minutes of math fact practice each night. Match fact logs to be signed by parent or guardian each night.
